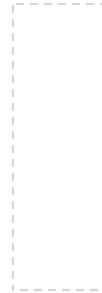

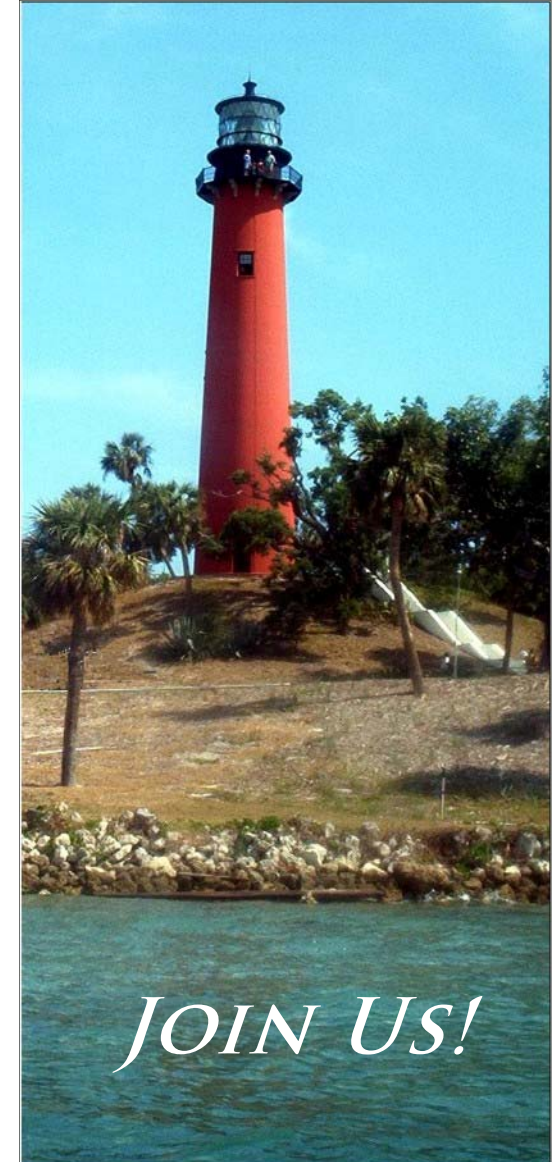

LOXAHATCHEE RIVER HISTORICAL SOCIETY

The Loxahatchee River Historical Society (LRHS) was formed in 1971 as a 501(c)3 non-profit organization dedicated to collecting, preserving, and promoting the history of the Loxahatchee River region. The Society operates the Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum, DuBois Pioneer Home — both listed on the National Register of Historic Places — and the historic George Washington Tindall House.

JUPITER INLET LIGHTHOUSE & MUSEUM

Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse & Museum offers climbing tours of the landmark 1860 lighthouse. The waterfront Museum in the newly restored WWII building offers indoor Florida history exhibits, outdoor exhibits, Tindall Pioneer Homestead, museum gift shop, Lecture Series, sunset tours, children's summer camp, weddings and special events. Through a lease with the US Coast Guard, the Society is solely responsible for the maintenance and public tour operations of the Jupiter Light. Help us preserve our historic lighthouse! Proper conservation and repair of this 1860 structure is vital. Your membership is a commitment to our treasured landmark.

DUBOIS PIONEER HOME

The Society offers a unique glimpse into early river life at the 1898 house museum which is located on an ancient Native American shell mound. This special site on the Jupiter Inlet is a favorite for educational field trips, Summer Camps and DuBois Park visitors.
